

Parking Lot Permits

Parking Permits are available for eight (8) City-owned downtown parking lots* (see map).

Please note that all-day parking permits can be purchased for the 5-hour metered parking spaces available in **any** of these parking lots.

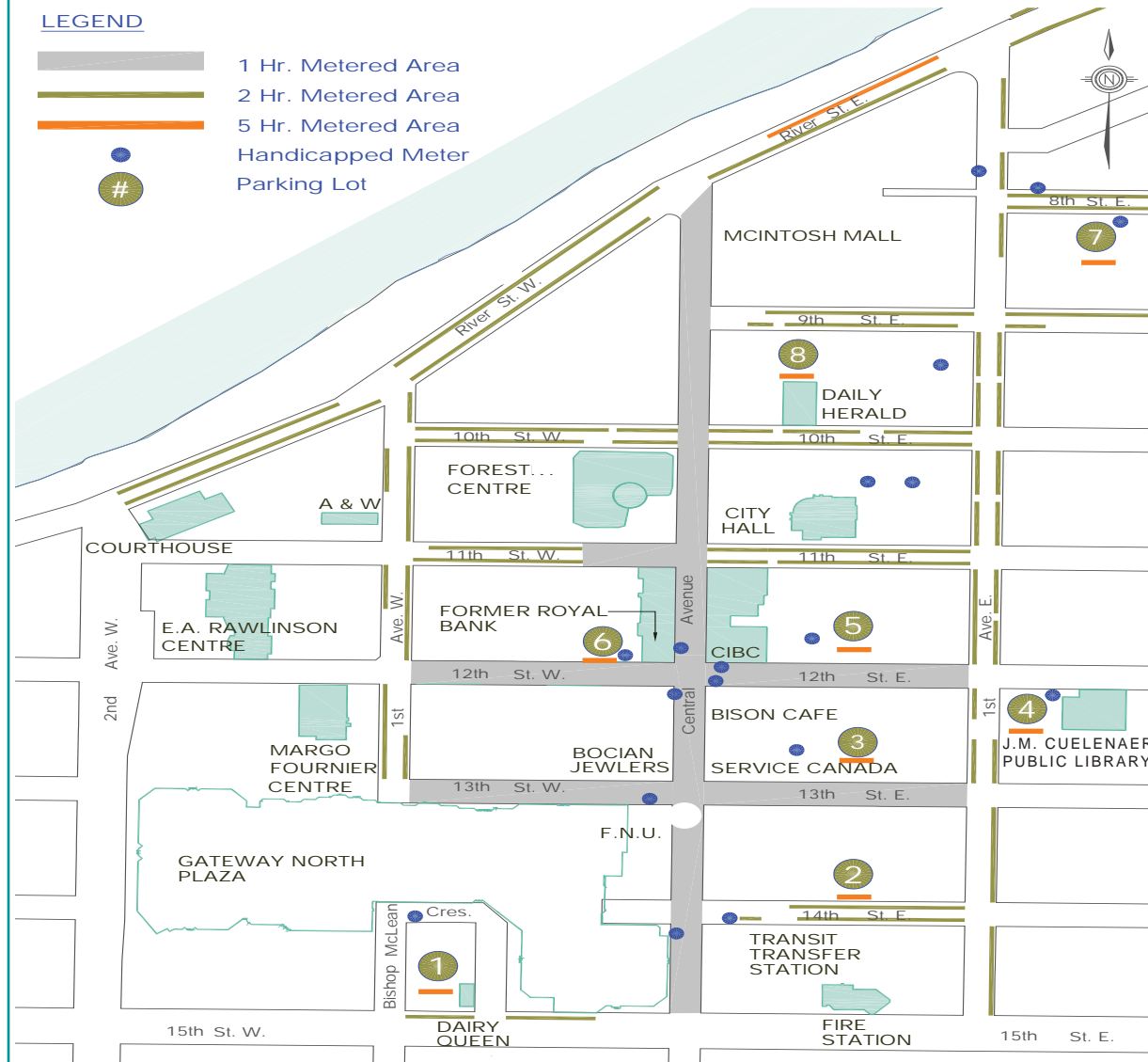

Parking Meters

Metered parking is available in the downtown ranging from 1 hour to five hours. This includes parking lots and on streets.

Parking Meter Rates (Central Ave and Lots):

Parking is **free** before 9am and after 6pm Monday to Friday.
Saturdays, park **free** for 2hours

Utility Parking Permits

Cost: \$140.00 plus GST per year

Utility parking permits are issued to those involved in providing utility maintenance or media news coverage in the downtown. Permit holders are allowed to park at one-, two- and five-hour parking meters.

Restricted Parking Permits

Cost: \$140.00 plus GST per year

Restricted parking permits are issued to those involved in general delivery or courier businesses and allow the permit holder to park:

- at a one-hour, two-hour or five-hour metered stall for the length of time required to load and unload the vehicle;
- in rear lanes of the Central Business District for no longer than required to load or unload;
- at loading zones designated for that purpose for no longer than indicated on the signs designating the loading zone.

Parking for Out of Town Visitors

Top Hat Program

Visitors to Prince Albert can request a “Top Hat” parking pass at the Visitor Centre (3700 2nd Avenue West) which will provide visitors with free parking for up to three days in the downtown core.

The Visitor Centre is open seven days a week from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during the summer season. For more information, please contact Prince Albert Tourism at 953-4386.

Out of Province Visitors

Visitors to the downtown with an out of province license plate can park for free in the downtown during the months of July and August every year.

Free Parking for Veterans

All vehicles displaying a valid Veteran License Plate issued by SGI may park free of charge at metered parking stalls.

The Veteran’s license plate must have a validated sticker on it and be displayed on the rear of the vehicle to be recognized for free parking.

Anyone interested in obtaining a Veteran License Plate should contact SGI for further information.

METERCARDS

METERCARDS are re-loadable cards that provide a convenient way to pay for parking at downtown parking meters.

Use a card instead of coins. Now available for sale at City Hall. Coins still accepted. Hourly time limits still apply. Instructions for use available at www.citypa.ca or when you purchase your card.

Parking Fines and Enforcement

Parking fines apply to all handicap parking spaces and fire lanes throughout the City including those at shopping centers and private lots.

	No Parking/ Expired Meters	Handicap	Fire Lane
Early Payment (If paid in 10 days)	\$10	\$150	\$50
Full Amount (If paid after 10 days)	\$25	\$300	\$100
If summons and court action required (If paid after 30 days)**	\$75	\$450	\$200

**\$40.00— Additional administration charge if convicted. After conviction, failure to pay will result in the issue moving to the enforcement stage.

If You Get a Parking Ticket

Payment Options:

By mail – the pink copy is a self addressed envelope. Cheque or money orders only.

In person – main floor of City Hall. Cash, cheques, debit cards and money orders are accepted.

Drop box – For after hours payments. Located outside City Hall’s west entrance. Cheque or money orders only.

If you receive a ticket after parking at a broken meter, go immediately to the Financial Services Department on the main floor of City Hall and fill out a complaint form.
